Kia ora Alex,

Thank you for your email. We have received and reviewed minute 2 of the Beachlands Expert Consenting Panel and have been busy working on the response to comments received and the further information requests.

We have been in contact with the Auckland Council Group who have expressed a willingness to participate in expert caucusing. The caucusing will be undertaken separately between the relevant specialists. We are currently liaising amongst ourselves to agree on an agenda and time for the conferencing to occur. We have been working to arrange separate meetings with the relevant specialists to ensure that caucusing is undertaken in the most efficient manner possible. The first meeting will take place tomorrow via MS Teams. However, given the time of year, it has been somewhat difficult to arrange meetings with all parties.

Whilst we were aiming to respond to the comments received by 31 January 2022 (and request processing resume on that date), we will now require additional time to ensure that the further information can be obtained, caucusing completed and agreed statements prepared. We are also undertaking further consultation to obtain a Cultural Impact Assessment. At this stage, we are not in a position to complete this process within the 1 working day timeframe (by 1 February 2022).

We will keep in contact with regards to timeframes, but at this stage we expect that we will be in a position to request that the Panel resumes processing mid-February 2022.
