Dominion Road Mixed-use Development resource consent application (the application)

M-14 Minute of the Dominion Road Mixed-use Development Expert
Consenting Panel – 3 September 2021

1. Minute 13 on 1 September 2021 directed the traffic and transportation experts to conference to prepare a joint statement and to provide that statement by 5pm on 9 September 2021.
2. Parties have since requested further guidance on who is expected to attend the expert conferencing.
3. The Panel confirms its intention is for the authors of the material received by it on 30 August 2021 from Auckland Transport, Stantec and Harrison Grierson to conference with the relevant experts engaged by the applicants.
4. The Panel has not included Auckland Council in this list, on the assumption it is relying on Auckland Transport in relation to traffic and transportation matters. If that assumption is incorrect, the relevant experts for Auckland Council may also attend.
5. The Panel understands the authors of the Auckland Transport response may well be employees of Auckland Transport and expects this will be acknowledged in the Joint Statement. The Panel does not expect Auckland Transport to engage an independent expert for the purpose of the witness conferencing.
6. The Panel has included its own advisor in the list of attendees. This has been done to assist the Panel gain a clear understanding of what it is agreed between the experts, what is not (and why) and the materiality or significance of those areas in dispute and to, hopefully, result in an efficient process.
