Good morning Gen,

The Panel's Minute 4 indicates that at the applicant's request, the application is suspended until 29 March 2022. In fact, our memorandum did not seek a specific end date for the suspension but gave that date as a rough indication subject to matters outside our control, including the impact of covid on consultant availability.

The purpose of this email is to confirm that FHL D is not going to be able to meet the 29 March date.

In addition, we understand that the PC49 decision is imminent but is unlikely to be available by 29 March.

We therefore respectfully request that the application remains on hold beyond 29 March. FHL D will request a new recommencement date at the earliest opportunity.
