COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 – comments sought on consent application for the Faringdon South West and South East Development Project

Thank you for your email of 28 June 2021 seeking my comments on the consent application for the Faringdon South West and South East Development Project by Hughes Developments Limited under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (the Act).

I support the intent of the project, being the subdivision, earthworks, construction of 970 residential units and two neighbourhood centres, and associated infrastructure south of Rolleston Township, in Canterbury.

I note that under the Act you must also seek comment from Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga (HNZPT). My officials have provided me with the comments HNZPT intend to make to your Panel.

I have reviewed HNZPT's comments and note their view that there has been insufficient archaeological assessment of the proposed development area. Given this, I endorse HNZPT's request for a condition of consent requiring an archaeological survey and assessment to be carried out prior to works commencing. I also support their request for the standard HNZPT Accidental Discovery Protocol to be a condition of consent.

Given the proposed conditions by HNZPT, I would appreciate the opportunity to review the draft conditions should your Panel decide to grant the consent.
