Request to suspend the processing of the Federal Street Residences Referred Project Application under the Covid-19 Recovery (Fast-Track Consenting) Act 2020


1. I act for P0012 Auckland NZ Pty Limited (**Applicant**) in relation to its application for resource consent to demolish a multi-stored parking building at 65-71 Federal Street, central Auckland, and construct a mixed-use high-rise building (**Application**) under the Covid-19 Recovery (Fast-Track Consenting) Act 2020 (**FTCA**).

Request for Suspension

2. Invitations to comment on the Application closed on 14 April 2022. As the Panel will be aware, an applicant has five working days within which to respond to comments received.
3. The Applicant requests the suspension of the processing of this Application pursuant to Schedule 6, clauses 6(1)(b)(ii) and 23 of the FTCA.
4. The purpose of the suspension is to provide an opportunity to consider and respond to comments received from invited parties. Some of the comments are lengthy and raise technical matters.

5. Given the context above, more than 5 working days are needed to provide a comprehensive response to the feedback.
6. I request the Panel suspend processing from 5pm, 21 March 2022.
7. This request falls within the timeframe set out in clause 23(2) of Schedule 6 as the Application has been provided to the Panel, but the Panel is yet to make a final decision on the Application.
8. At the time of writing, the timeframe required to prepare a comprehensive response is unknown. Accordingly, I do not nominate a defined end date to the suspension request.
9. During the suspension period the Panel may wish to continue to review and assess the Project in the interim, given the statutory time constraints. To the extent necessary, the Applicant confirms that it agrees to and will fund any such work undertaken during the period of suspension.
