M-5 Minute of the Federal Street Residences Expert Consenting Panel – 29 June 2022

Suspension of Processing

1. On 21 April 2022, correspondence was received from Jeremy Brabant (Legal Counsel), on behalf of P0012 Auckland NZ Pty Limited (the Applicant), requesting that processing of the application for Federal Street Residences be suspended under clause 23(1) of Schedule 6 of the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (the Act).
2. The Federal Street Residences Expert Consenting Panel (the Panel) granted the request to suspend the processing of the Application, with processing ceasing at 11 59pm on 21 April 2022.

Resumption of Processing

3. On 27 June 2022, correspondence was received from Jeremy Brabant, on behalf of the Applicant, requesting that the processing of the Application be resumed in accordance with clause 23(6) of Schedule 6 of the Act.
4. In accordance with clause 23(7) of Schedule 6 of the Act, if the Panel receives a request to resume processing, it must, as soon as reasonably practicable, resume processing of the application.
5. As such, the suspension of processing of the Federal Street Residences application ceased at **11 59pm 28 June 2022**, and the Panel resumed processing on **29 June 2022**.

Timeframes

6. At 11:59pm on 27 June 2022, when the suspension of processing the Application began, 3 working days of the 25-working day timeframe specified in clause 37(2)(a) of Schedule 6 of the Act, by which the Panel must issue its final decision (where there has been no further extension to that time-period), had elapsed.
7. Therefore, as of 29 June 2022, with the cessation of the suspension of processing, there are 22 working days remaining by which the Panel must issue its decision (where no further extension of the timeframe specified in clause 37(2)(a) of Schedule 6 of the Act has been applied).

8. The Panel reserves its right to extend the timeframe by which it must issue its decision by, if required.
