Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the consent application.

Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga notes that there are no recorded archaeological sites on the property, i.e. none shown on the NZAA Archsite database. Upon further inspection of aerial photography it appears that most of the land is former wet lands, however there does appear to be a couple of slightly raised areas. These raised areas are generally where occupation occurred, and there is potential for the discovery of archaeological material in these areas.

Therefore, we recommend using the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Accidental Recovery Protocol, as a condition, with a standard advice note about the requirements of the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act. We also recommend a supporting condition that those working on the site be supplied with copies of the ADP and advice note.

Recommended additions to the draft conditions supplied by the applicant

Advice note 19 to be replaced with the following condition:

Archaeological conditions

x. In the event of any discovery of archaeological material, work shall stop immediately in the vicinity of the discovery and the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Accidental Discovery Protocol, attached as Appendix X, shall be followed.

xx. The consent holder shall ensure that all contractors and staff working on the site are supplied with a copy of the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Accidental Discovery Protocol in Appendix X.

Advice Note:

Advice Note: It is an offence under s87 of the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act 2014 to modify or destroy an archaeological site without an authority from Heritage New Zealand irrespective of whether the works are permitted or consent has been issued under the Resource Management Act or other legislation.

Advice note: Special care should be taken if excavating in the vicinity of any raised areas on the site. . These raised areas are generally where occupation occurred, and there is potential for the discovery of archaeological material in these areas.
