Tēnā koe,

Please see below a reply in regards to the Invitation to Comment on Draft Conditions - Kapuni Green Hydrogen Project.

PKW have reviewed the Draft Conditions of Consent vs the original Proposed Conditions of Consents and make the following comments;

Misc. Reference to the Assessment of Environmental Effects dated 18/08/2021. This is a later version to that referenced in the proposed conditions that was previously reviewed by PKW. PKW request a copy of this latest AEE and wish to reserve the right to comment further as the owner of the whenua on which the wind turbines will be located.

Clause 73 & 74 - Lizard survey. PKW are not opposed to the introduction of these clauses, but request additional detail in regards to 74 d) on-going maintenance requirements.

Clause – 88 - Archaeology. PKW support the formalisation of a discovery protocol process and the presence of cultural monitors during earthworks (clause 91).

Clause 94 – 97 - Air Traffic Safety. PKW are not opposed to the introduction of these clauses.

Clause 110 – 113 - Decommissioning and Site Rehabilitation. PKW support these clauses and request to have some oversight / input within the decommissioning plan for those assets on PKW whenua.

Clause 118 - Peer review. PKW seek to be included to receive the results of the on-going monitoring of the resource consent.

PKW seek continued engagement on any proposed amendments to the Draft Resource Consent conditions that result out of the Invitation to Comment on Draft Conditions – Kapuni Green Hydrogen Project process.
