On 10 August 2020 the Te Tai Tokerau Water Trust lodged a consent application with the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) for the Matawii Water Storage Reservoir under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (the Act). On 17 August 2020 the EPA determined that it complied with clause 3(1) and it was referred to the Matawii Expert Consenting Panel for processing and decision by the end of October.

Your comments must be returned to the EPA no later than 21 September 2020.
