Tēnā koe,

I have had very limited time to respond to these conditions and therefore very briefly add my comments below:

Page 2, condition 9

- A detailed description of what those offsite impacts could be, the likelihood of effect and the confidence level around the assessments made, provided to neighbouring properties and kaitiaki.
- A condition should also be included that, prior to commencement an assurance is given to affected neighbouring landowners that any affect in their own personal insurance will be covered by the consent holder in perpetuity.

Page 3, condition 17 and 18

- Both the CEAP and EAP are provided to neighbouring properties and kaitiaki.

Page 6, condition 40

- How will bare areas be stabilised following completion? What does that look like?

Page 6, condition 43 & 45

- Construction activities undertaken Monday to Saturday- given this is a private and quiet road (wallis road) currently with minimal traffic it would be more considerate if work started at 9am on a Saturday, waking up to trucks going up and down the road on your day off is less than ideal.
- Repairs must take place to the public road immediately, if damaged by construction traffic- any damage incurred to vehicles that would normally frequent Wallis road will be rectified by the consent holder.

Page 7, condition 52

- Condition to be added that the speed limit travelling down wallis road at any time will be reduced to 30km to reduce dust and incidents- my children ride their bikes up and down this road and with an increased flow of heavy traffic the minimum safety requirement would be to reduce the speed limit & have the appropriate controls and signage in place.
