Further information Requested

1. On 10 June 2021 the Nola Estate Expert Consenting Panel (**the Panel**) directed the Environmental Protection Authority (**EPA**) to issue a second request for information to CPM 2019 Limited (**the applicant**) in accordance with Clause 25(1) of Schedule 6 of the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (**the Act**).
2. On 28 July 2021, the applicant provided a suite of updated application documents
3. In accordance with Clause 25(1)(a), the Panel requested further information from Auckland Council, Auckland Transport and Watercare. The Panel requested any further information they may wish to provide by Monday 16 August on all the new material made available by the applicant. This information was provided before or on Monday 16 August 2021.

Further comments requested

5. In accordance with Clause 25(4), as soon as reasonably practicable after the information is received by the EPA, the EPA must provide electronic copies of this information to every person or group that provided comments on the application under Clause 17(2) of Schedule 6 of the Act. However, Clause 25(5) of Schedule 6 of the Act states that those that receive the information may not make further comments unless requested by the Panel.
6. In accordance with Clause 25(5) of Schedule 6 of the Act the Panel has requested that the applicant make further comments on the information received. If the applicant wishes to make further comment, they must provide this information to the EPA by **Friday 27 August**.
