COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 – comments sought on consent application for the Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 Improvements Project

Thank you for your email of 3 September 2021 seeking my comments on the consent application for the Papakura to Drury South State Highway 1 Improvements Project by Waka Kotahi under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020 (the Act).

I support the intent of the project, being to carry out road improvements along State Highway 1 between Papakura and Drury, Auckland.
