Apply now for an allocation of NZUs

It's time to submit your application for the next round of industrial allocations of New Zealand Units (NZUs, also known as carbon credits).

Your application must be with us by Saturday 30th of April 2017. Late applications cannot be accepted.

This year, you will need to log in to the [New Zealand Emissions Trading Register](#) to access the online application form. You will need to be a registered user who has access to your company's account on this system. For help getting access, please contact us using the details below.

Do you have to apply?

If you received a provisional allocation of NZUs last year, you are legally obliged to make an application by 30 April 2017. If you have not previously applied for an allocation, or if you received a final allocation last year, applying is optional.

What type of application should you make?

There are several types of application you can make; your choice depends on what you did last year, and what you'd like to do in the future.
